

*Independent Sculpture Study with David Boyajian*

*Registration Information for Spring & Summer 2005*

Metal fabrication workshops will be held on Mondays, Wednesday s and Saturdays at the Boyajian Sculpture Barn. Each session runs for a four week cycle and begins on or close to the first Monday, Wednesday and Saturday of each month.

These semi private workshops are designed to produce maximum results. Bring your project idea and realize it under the tutalidge of master sculptor, David Boyajian.

The studio is equiped with four welders; two for steel, one for stainless and aluminum and one for bronze. Additional fully operational equipment includes, rollers, plasma cutter, nibblers, drill press, metal band saw, and more.

*The optimum class size is three students therefore we must ask for a pre-registration commitment to keep the class full but not over booked. You may sign-up for more than one session at a time.*

Fee for each session is \$425.00 and includes materials such as gas, tips and rods. Students are responsible for bringing their own sheet metal however we have plenty of scrap to get you started. A deposit of \$200 is required to register and the balance is due at the first class.
